• Following a suggestion from the Parish Council Clerk, the local veterans' group have proposed to hold a community event to commemorate the 80th anniversary of D-Day on Saturday, 8th June 2024 between 2 pm and 5 pm at the Memorial Hall. The group already has flags and memorabilia for decorating the hall. They have considered entertainment and inclusion of local school children. The Parish Council would be responsible for considering a way to ensure the event is made available to residents of West Auckland and St Helens only. It was resolved that the Parish Council will consider contributing a minimum of £500 and maximum of £1,000 for the event at the December meeting.
